



*AMENDED ASG Meeting Minutes for August 23, 2011*

Meeting called to order at 12:15 p.m.

Attendance was taken. All present except Jordan Matthews and Ledoux Okamba, both who had excused absences.

There were no previous minutes.

First discussion was that Senator B. Kaiser failed to attend the mandatory retreat, despite numerous numerous texts, emails, Facebook messages, an in-person conversations reminding her of the retreat and that it was mandatory for all ASG members to attend. ASG President Alex Barker personally discussed with her the dates of the retreat and the fact that the retreat was mandatory.

A motion was made by Mark Devenney to impeach Ms. Kaiser. Brittanie Hyatt seconded the motion. A written vote was taken of all ASG members and at 12:23 the results was 8 to 2 in favor of impeachment. This vote was 2/3rds majority. Ms. Kaiser was and impeached and a letter was to be written informing Ms. Kaiser of the decision.

The Executive Board will meet at 08:30 on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Mandatory nature of desks hours by ASG senators was discussed. This requirement will begin soon.

We were informed that Dr. Grant Wilson, Vice-President of Student Services will be attending the ASG meeting on Thursday, August 25, 2011. ASG senators were reminded that parliamentary procedures will be in effect; this will ensure that the meeting will run smoothly.

ASG members were reminded to bring their binders to all ASG meetings.

Advisor J. Rigg recited a parable about the wind and the sun.

ASG was then informed about a proposed policy affecting scholarships. This policy is more onerous for students at LCCC and raises the minimum GPA for scholarships from 2.5 to 3.0, regardless of the sponsor's desires.

It has been decided that ASG will submit a letter requesting 4 weeks extension in order to obtain the voice of the students as to this issue as well as other public comment.

Members were reminded that we are looking for additional senators and that applications are available in the CLL Office.

Misty Heil moved at 1:03 to adjourn the meeting. Ben Pratt seconded. Meeting adjourned.
