1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The Board of Trustees of Laramie County Community College (LCCC) believes it is their responsibility to provide an educational environment conducive to learning and exploration in which individuals and their property are protected from harm. The Board has established policies pertaining to appropriate student conduct (See Student Code of Conduct Policy 3.15 and Student Rights and Responsibilities Policy 3.17), and charged the President of LCCC with the adoption of administrative procedures for the identification of behavioral expectations at the College and to explain the protocol in the event of a violation of this expectations. (See Student Code of Conduct Procedure 3.15P and Student Rights and Responsibilities Procedure 3.17P.)

The Board also believes that when an apparent violation of the student code of conduct is identified, that the College will respond with an objective and fair process for the adjudication of such claims. To that end, the Board charges the President to provide a process for dealing with these alleged violations. Therefore, the purpose of this policy is to clarify the Board's expectations of the College's due process for responding to Student Code of Conduct violations with its Administrative Procedures.
