Work progresses on Flexible Industrial Technology and Student Services and University Center

FLEXIBLE INDUSTRIAL TECH BUILDING

- The walls are going up! Precast concrete walls are being erected now for the central pod of the Flexible Industrial Technology Building. Take a look to the east, and you'll see the new building taking shape right before your eyes. The work on the walls should be completed Sept. 22.
- FCI will begin to set steel on the north pod on Sept. 22 and on the south pod on Oct. 1.



STUDENT SERVICES/UNIVERSITY CENTER

- A pedestrian walkway has been installed on the west side of the construction site from the northwest Arena parking lot to the Blue Arches.
- Time-lapse cameras are installed. The cameras will show the progress of the buildings in still shots.
- Precast installation on the east stair tower will begin Sept.
 23 and will be completed Sept.
 25.
- East stair precast will be installed on Oct. 7 and 8.
- Basement steel and deck will begin Oct. 13.



PARKING

Parking will be allowed in all established parking lots, with the exception of:

- Residence Hall parking lots–permit only
- South-side of Auto Body
- Any grass or dirt areas
- Within any fenced area
