RE: End of Semester Numbers


Included in this memo are the end of semester numbers for 18/SP. The numbers included below not only highlight the great work of the institution as a whole, but also the dedication and commitment of the Office of the Registrar staff. The end of the semester is filled with numerous processes which must be completed in a short window of time to ensure the needs of our students are met as soon as possible after the end of the semester. It is my pleasure to share these numbers with you.

After the final grades were received on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, we accomplished the following:


- Conferred 492 credentials to 439 students. (There may be a couple more once we receive official transcripts from other institutions.)
- Sent 14 "no" letters to those who did not graduate
- Posted Academic Standing which includes:
 - President's Honor Roll 300 students
 - Vice President's Honor Roll 168 students
 - Interstate Passport 35 students
 - General Education Transfer Block 171 students' transcripts were noted as having completed the General Education Core.
 - Interstate Passport and General Education Transfer Block 9 students received both transcript notations.
 - Probation 216 students (328 for 17/FA; 229 for 17/SP; 400 for 16/FA)
 - 56 students on probation for 18/SP were returned to good standing after grades posted for the semester. This means their cumulative GPA returned to above a 2.0. Of these 53 students, 8 were originally suspended after 17/FA, but successfully appealed and were given another probationary semester. They capitalized on this opportunity and are now in good standing.
 - Suspension 132 students (103 for 17/FA; 152 for 17/SP; 86 for 16/FA)
 - There were 14 students dropped for 18/SU all ¾ time of less and 15 dropped for 18/FA 8 full-time and the rest ¾ time or less.
- Processed/sent 806 official transcripts between May 11 and June 14.

In addition to degrees conferred and academic standing for spring, degree totals increased significantly for FY18. A comparison of both credentials awarded and the number of graduates is included on the next page.
