RE: Recommendations for Program Suspension and Closure

The Guided Pathways initiative at LCCC has defined work throughout the College since 2017. The project is designed to assist colleges in the examination of the impact internal practices have on students' ability to complete an intentionally defined credential in order to meet their career and/or educational goals. Thus far the Pathways work has resulted in a redefined General Education program, the restructured Advising model, and a reorganization in Academic Affairs to group programs into distinct areas of common interest, or Pathways.

This reorganization serves the first pillar of Guided Pathways, "Clarify the Path." This essential practice challenged the College to design clearly mapped programs that are aligned with further education and careers. Such programs allow the institution to fulfill its promise to students that a quality credential can be earned in a reasonable amount of time, and that the credential would lead to opportunities not otherwise accessible to them. The faculty-lead examination of all current programs at LCCC has resulted in this request to deactivate (close) several programs and to place several others on hiatus (suspend) starting in the Fall 2020 semester.

Hiatus essentially means that the College will be <u>temporarily</u> placing the program in a suspended state, where students are not able to enroll in the program. Yet the program is not closed or deactivated. This is done to allow for time to further examine the demand and need for the program, and to allow for program changes or redesign if it is deemed still viable. The following credentials have been recommended by the faculty for Hiatus (suspension):

Deactivation means the College will be <u>permanently</u> closing the program. Students will no longer be able to enroll in the program and LCCC does not plan to bring the program back, in any format, for the foreseeable future. The following programs have been recommended by the faculty for deactivation (closure):

Three important notes. First, LCCC will offer a "teach out" plan for these programs. This means that active students currently enrolled in these credential programs will have the opportunity to finish their programs. In addition, the College is notifying non-active students who had chosen these programs when they were enrolled and allowing them to come back to LCCC and finish their programs if they enroll for Spring Semester 2020.

Second, while the scope of these changes appears voluminous it is important to state that LCCC will continue to provide pathways for those students declaring an interest in the areas formerly served by these programs. These options are embedded in the newly established Pathways structure which allows for focused exploration of areas of interest and the development of individualized academic plans to serve the career and/or transfer goals of our students.

Third, and most important, it is imperative that we not focus on what programs options are being eliminated, but rather what we are providing for our students and our community. To that end, appended to this memorandum is the list of the active programs that are available and will continue to be offered by LCCC as of the 2020-2021 Catalog.

Considerable analysis, discourse, and effort has gone into making these decisions. These decisions are grounded in what LCCC believes is best for students and promoting student success. In general, the specific rationale for the recommended changes in program status included the following:

- Historically low program enrollments/majors;
- Low persistence and/or completion rates for students;
- Limited ability as a stand-alone credential to secure living-wage career placement;
- Lack of alignment with four-year articulation partners that are realistic pathways for students; and/or
- Authenticity/uniqueness of the degree program when compared to similar programs at LCCC (e.g., few courses differentiating them).

**Staff Recommendation:** That the Board of Trustees approves the placement of the identified programs into hiatus status, suspending their offerings starting Fall of 2020, and the deactivation of the identified programs, closing them effective Fall of 2020.
