1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

Laramie County Community College is committed to creating and sustaining a culture of ethical, professional, and lawful conduct, including the proper stewardship of all LCCC resources and appropriate relationships with LCCC stakeholders.

In the pursuit of mission attainment, there are numerous pressures and priorities. The needs of constituents and stakeholders, the professional standards of LCCC employees' disciplines and fields, and the requirements of funders, legislators, regulators and accreditors all present points of possible conflict. To maintain the public trust LCCC must constantly strive to operate with integrity and follow the assumed practices of institutions of higher education and the professions within higher education.


The purpose of this policy is to state the Board's position regarding their expectations and to charge the President with establishing appropriate procedures and processes for setting expectations and managing processes when a potential for conflict arises.
