Action Thomson, 36-year-cid MVA victim, fourth day post op with a splerectority and femul repair. He is experiencing new onset of shortness of breath and his a robal canula with 21, of Oxygen in place. He is restless with slight conductor but is easily orientated with attempts from name. Temperature spiked during the night to 1024, BP now 148,94 which is slightly elevated, respirations at 30 bpm and slightly labored, heart rate 102 versus B4 from last right shift. Skin could so touch and appears pale, His cooghing, to clear his arrawy, appears ineffective. Record cheat X-ray shows diffuse bilateral interestinal inflittrates in all lobes. Recent blood gives demonstrate falling PAO2 (hypocamiq) and increasing CO2 (Hypocapisa). Mr. Thomason is anxious and is obviously wicesened from the shift before in www.it.condition.






Learning Commons and Exam Lab


