# Challenges and Opportunities

- Budgetary obstacles
  - Decrease in full-time faculty due to 2020 RIF procedure
    - Adapting GenEd loads to meet Pathways
  - Replacement of specialty equipment (gas kilns)
- Decrease in enrollment and recruitment
  - Questions on contact and travel
    - Possible development of online recruitment tools
- Renovated space
  - Ongoing learning with ventilation
    - Accessibility to other media such as oil painting
  - Online/Hybrid effects on use of space

- **Online Positive Attribute**
  - “I loved the audio lessons! I wish all of my online classes offered this, it was much more enjoyable than just reading text and filling out discussions, as most online classes do.”
- **Structure Positive Attribute**
  - “Projects are well outlined with instructions on what the teacher wants, when its due, what is needed to be turned in, and the various steps for the whole project.”
- **Instructor Knowledge Positive Attribute**
  - “The instructor provides excellent examples of the course subject either from the internet or in the lecture. The instructor is extremely knowledge about the subject and presents it in a way that for me personally peaks my interest in further”
- **External Positive Attribute**
  - “It was helpful that the instructor required me to go out in our community and go to art galleries to view the art that we are talking about, and to help me understand the varying differences in art.”
- **Technology Positive Attribute**
  - “All of the material that was discussed in class (PowerPoints) was available to me online including certain helpful study material.”
- **General Positive Attribute**
  - “There wasn't anything that did not help me learn.”
- **Instructor Positive Attribute**
  - “All of this class was helpful to me. I had never before been very successful at drawing from life, this was all new to me. That challenged me. Mr. Maw encouraged me to challenge myself, and taught me so many things I had never considered before. Charcoal is the best! I understand the relationship of light in drawings now, and that unlocked everything.”
- **Content Positive Attribute**
  - “being exposed to new ideas and different styles of work has help me to move forward in painting.”
