Data Analytics AAS

- Expansion of Data Analytics Systems CD
 - Datacenter Specialist CD – Foundational IT knowledge and experience
 - General Education Requirements – Focused on practical skillsets for enterprise data careers
 - Data Analytics CD – Practical Application of modern data management systems
- Graduates will sit for 7 industry certifications in the course of the program

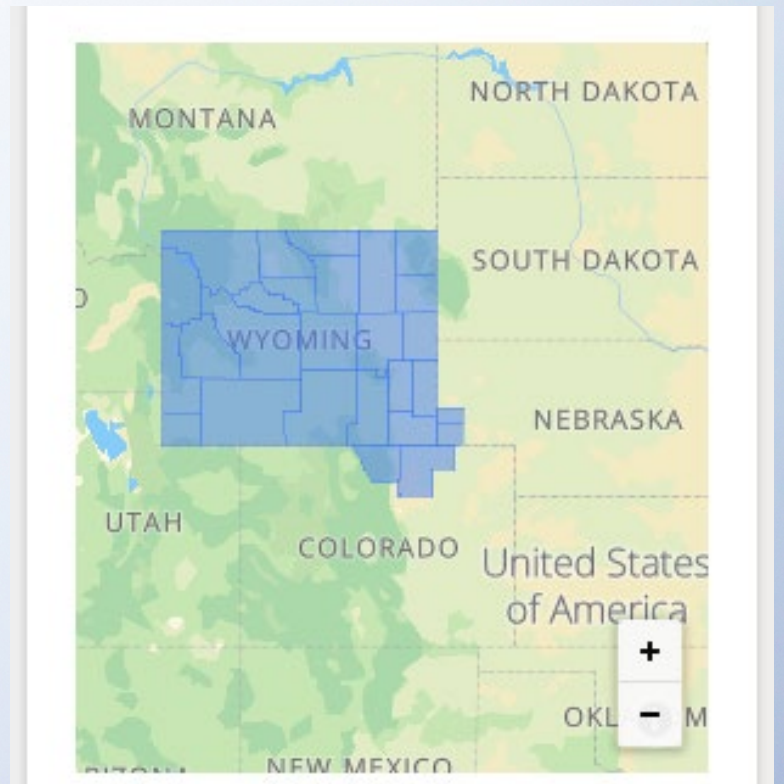

 - Approached from an *Application* perspective as opposed to the traditional Data Science track
 - Focused on practical usage of business market and performance data
 - Built on the fastest growing platforms
 - PowerBI
 - Azure Machine Learning
 - Dynamics 365
- 32-week program, designed for industry professionals or those with foundational IT education such as the Datacenter Specialist CD
 - Industry certification of skills
 - Practical demonstration of application
- Students will sit for 4 industry certifications in the course of the program

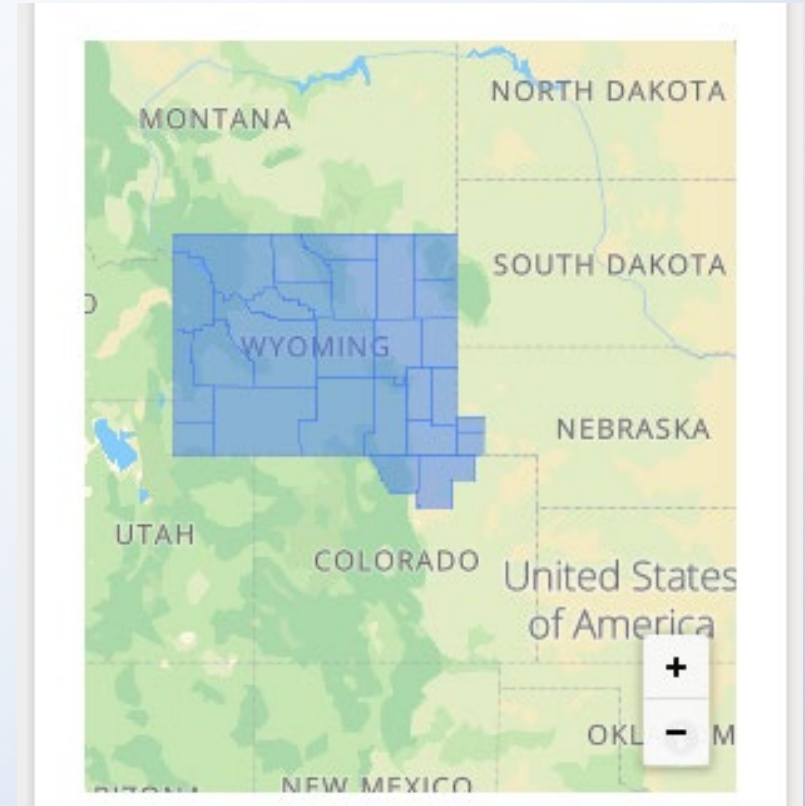

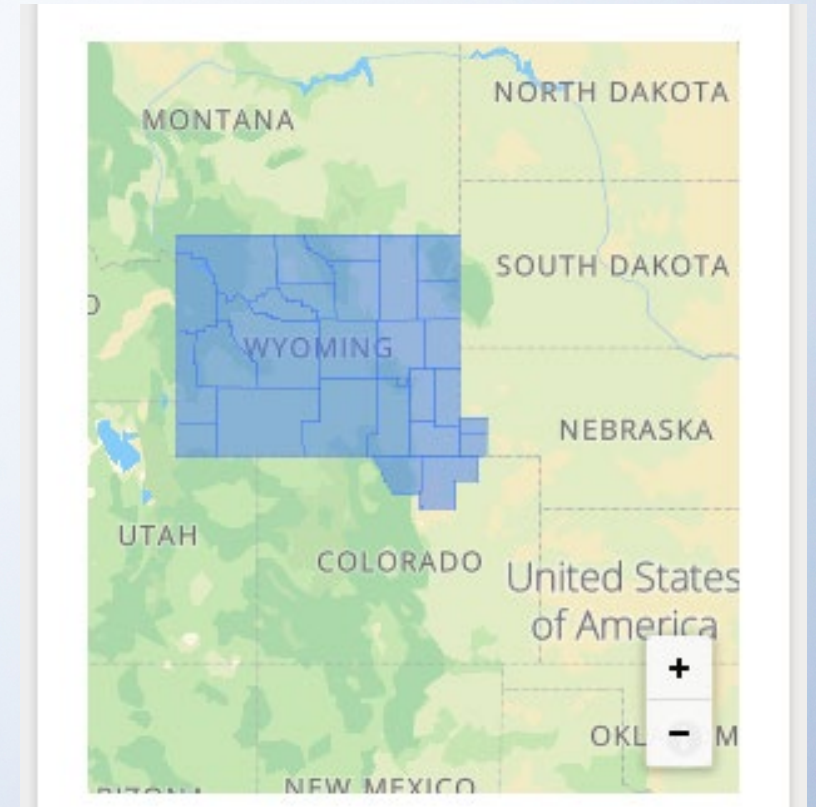
Telecommunications Specialist CD

 - SysAdmin skillsets at 4-year degree programs
 - 3000 – 4000 level coursework

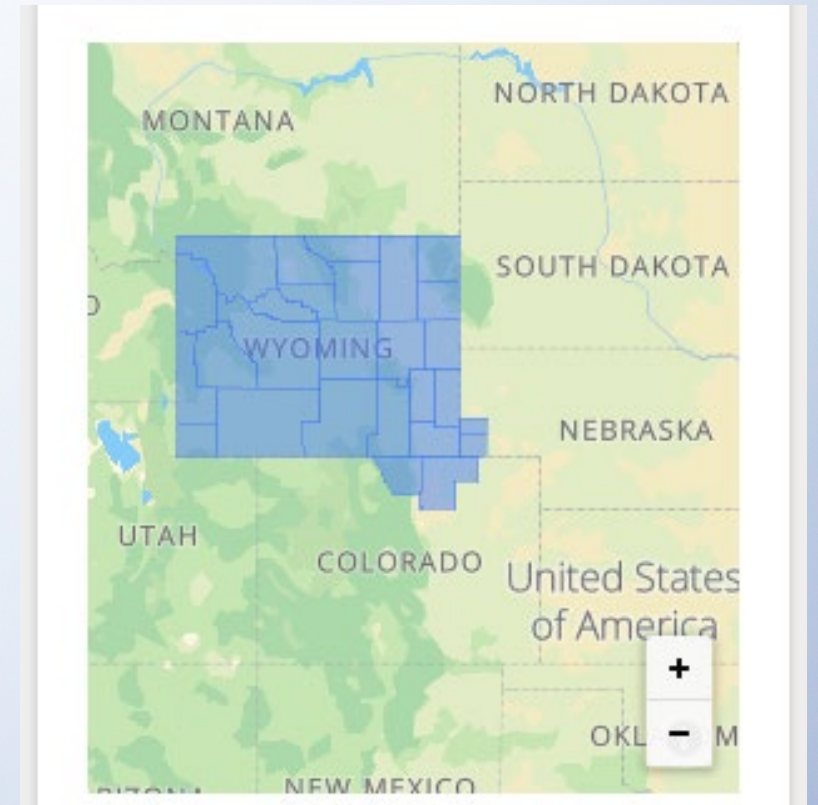
