What will LCCC students earn and learn?

- Patrol Peace Officer Path
 - WHP Basic Academy CD
 - Wyoming Highway Patrol Academy CD
 - Patrol Peace Officer AAS
- The degree path furthers the LCCC partnership with the WHP
- Cadets receive 36 credits with the completion of the basic and WHP specific academies and an additional 25 credits for the full AAS degree.
- Encompasses
 - Basic Patrol Peace Officer training
 - Specialized Patrol training in the WHP academy
 - Students are encouraged to complete the AAS upon completion of the academy; allows students to seek bachelor's and higher level education
 - Advanced degrees allows patrol officers to advance more quickly and earn higher salaries

- "Bright Outlook" with faster than average growth
- Predicts 5-7% growth from 2019 -2029

Career Coach

- Regional projections (Wyoming, Western Nebraska and the northern part of the Colorado front range) demonstrate even higher growth with a 16.5% increase from 2018-2030
- Statistics show that obtaining a certificate or associates degree are more the trend in law enforcement
- Wages are average, but increased earning potential and job advancement can be obtained with higher education
- The employment projection for this career field continues to grow



After LCCC, where will our majors go?

- Most will enter the workforce as Law Enforcement Officers
- Students successfully completing the WHP academy will be hired by the WHP upon graduation
 - Upon completion of the WHP academy, students will receive 36 credit hours in the two CD options, WHP Basic and the Wyoming Highway Patrol Academy
 - Students are encouraged to complete the remaining 25 credits in AAS upon graduation from the academy
 - Completion of the AAS will allow students to enroll in the Applied Management BAS at LCCC
