GEC Growth

- Significant growth since 2021/2022 in Revenue and Club Membership
- Currently have over 130 total members including sponsors
- Event revenue not included but expected to be \$30000 (double last year)

GEC Growth

- 34% increase in booster and sponsorships over last year

Use of Funds

- 2022/2023 Funds
 - \$60,000+ in scholarships for 2023/2024
 - AD requests
 - Video equipment for streaming
 - Meal-plans for assistant coaches
 - Gift cards for assistant coaches
 - Hall of Fame Weekend Support
 - Remaining amount put into reserves

- Future Expectations/Goals
 - 80 to 90% of total funds go to scholarships
 - 100% of corporate sponsorships and individual booster contributions go to scholarships
