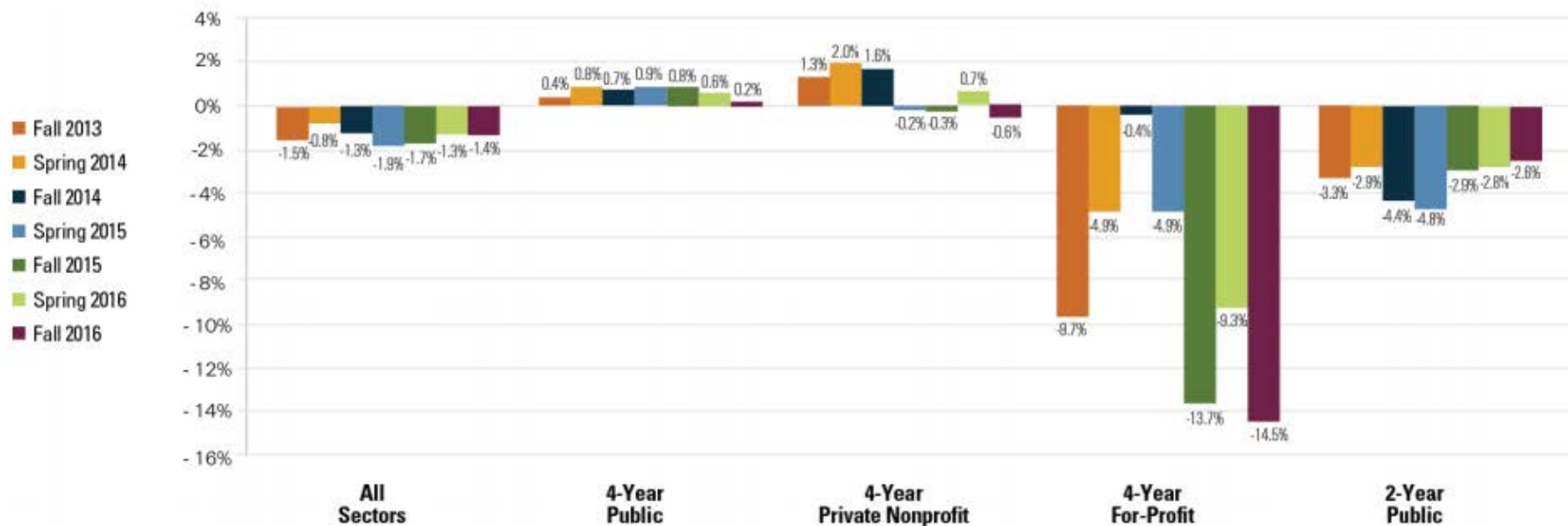

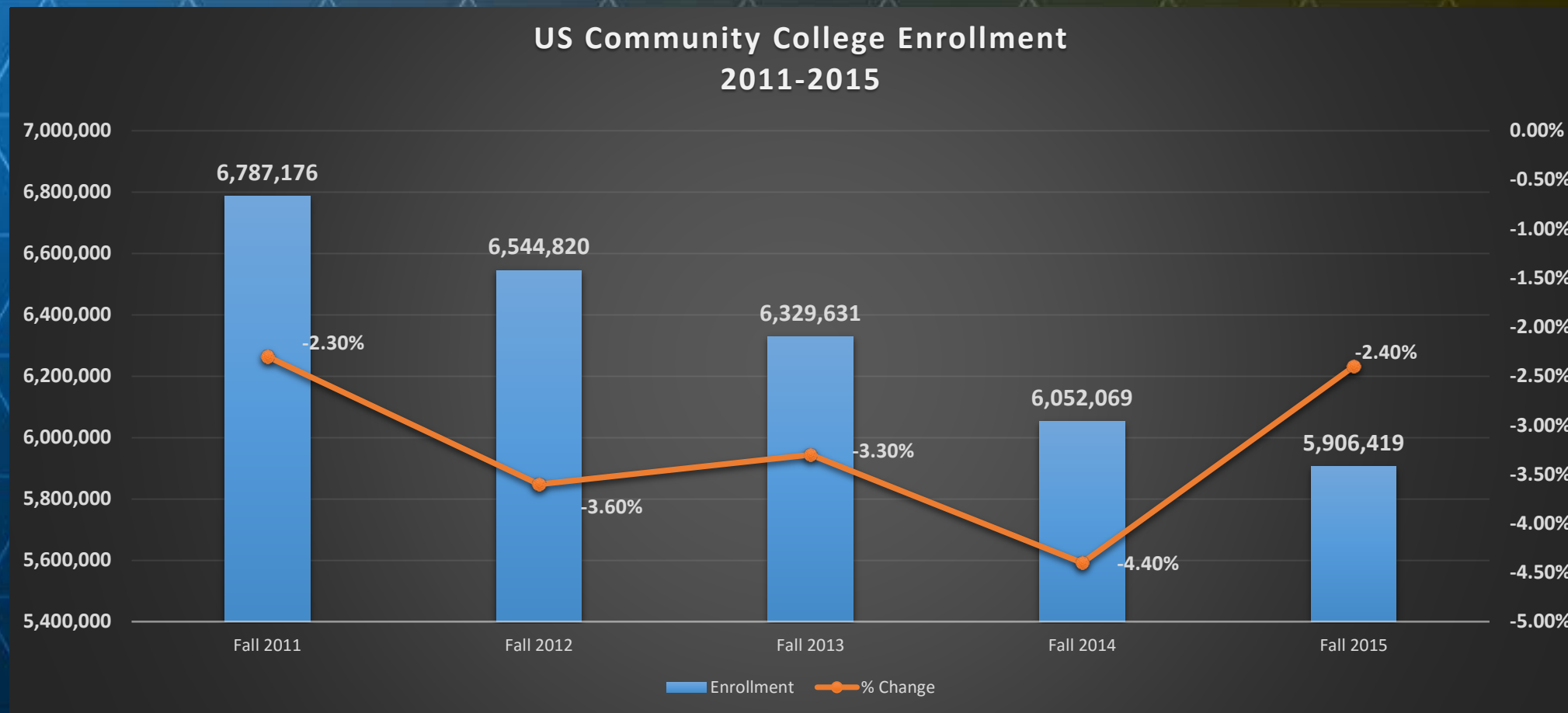

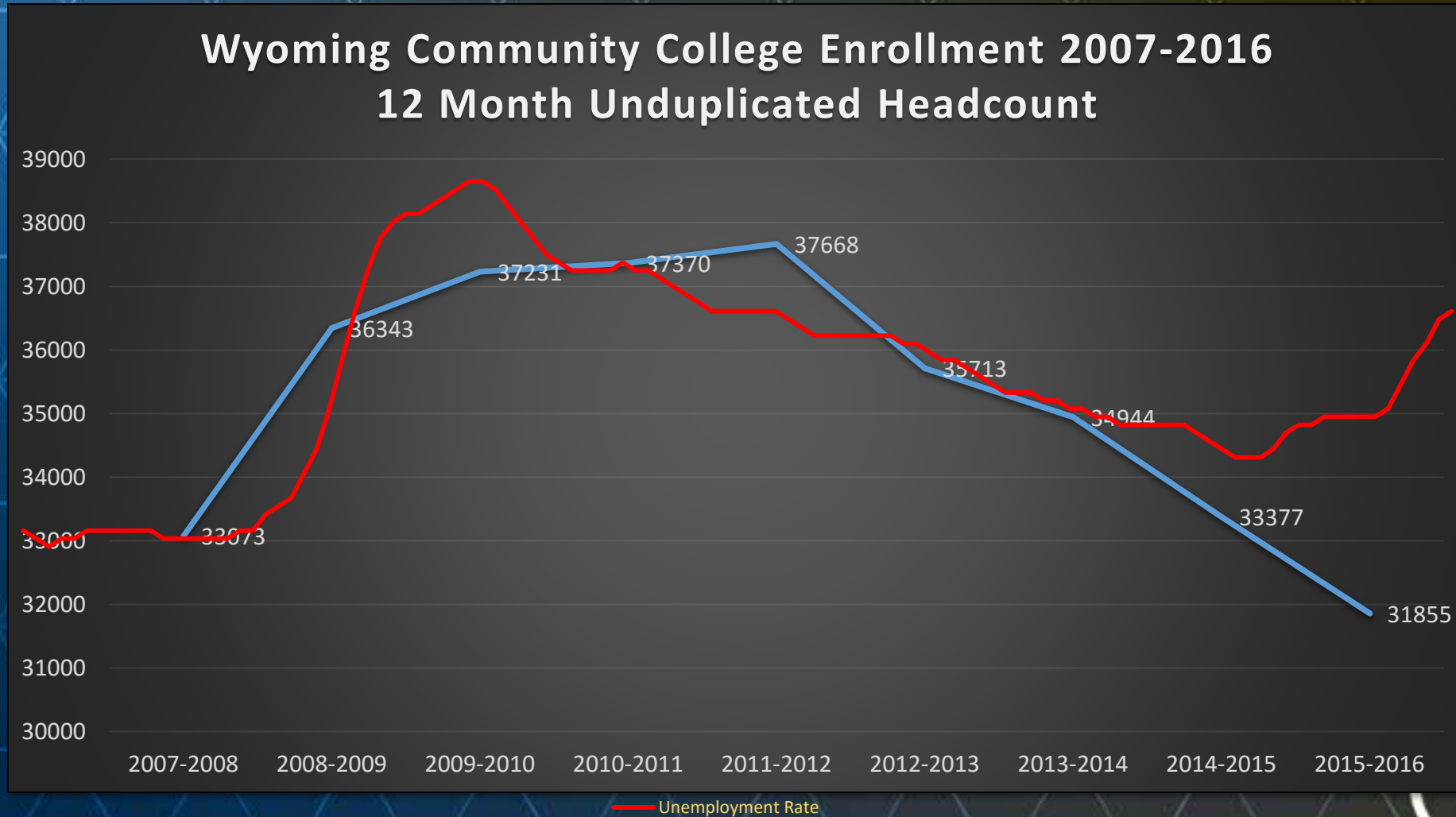
Figure 1: Percent Change from Previous Year, Enrollment by Sector (Title IV, Degree-Granting Institutions)



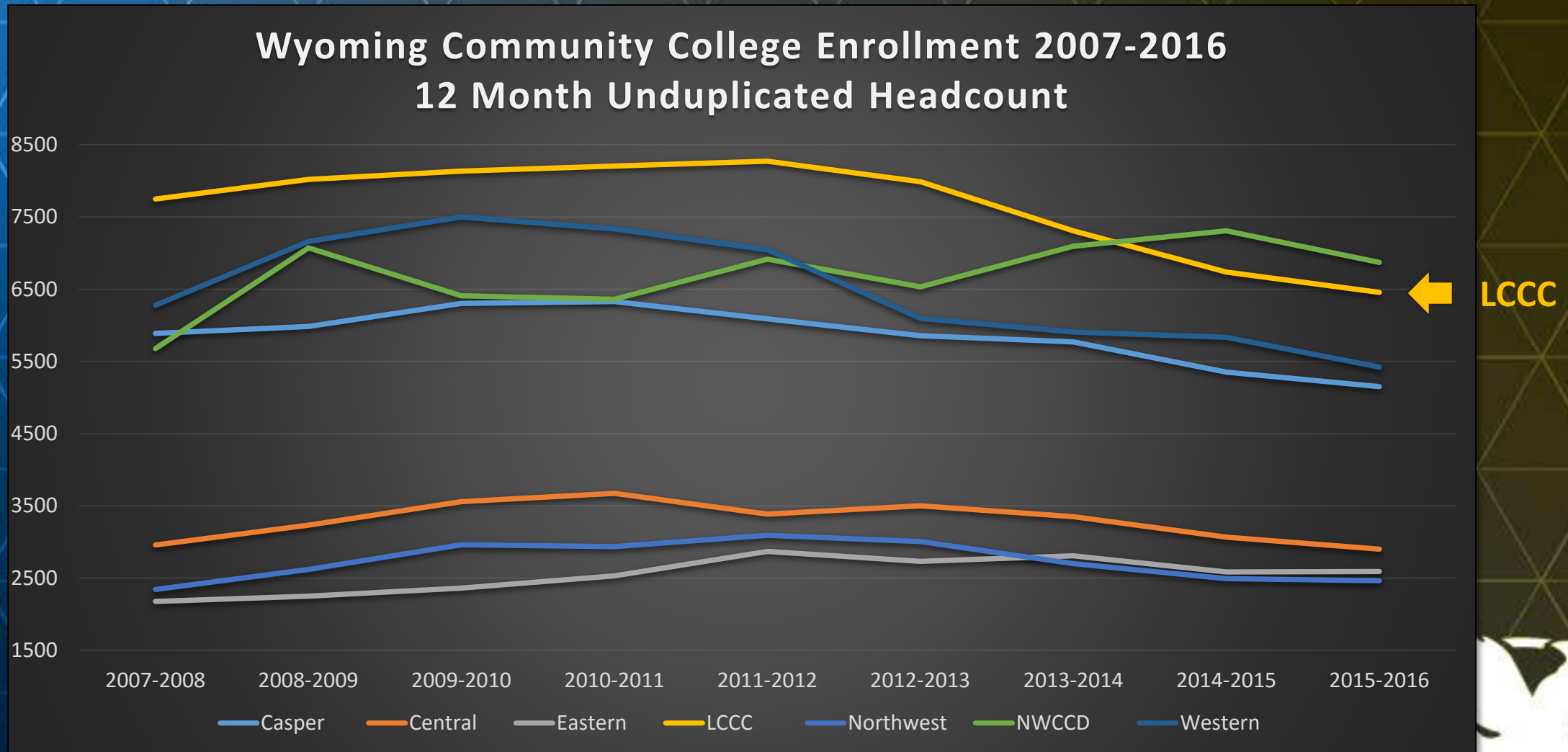
CC Enrollment Down Nationwide



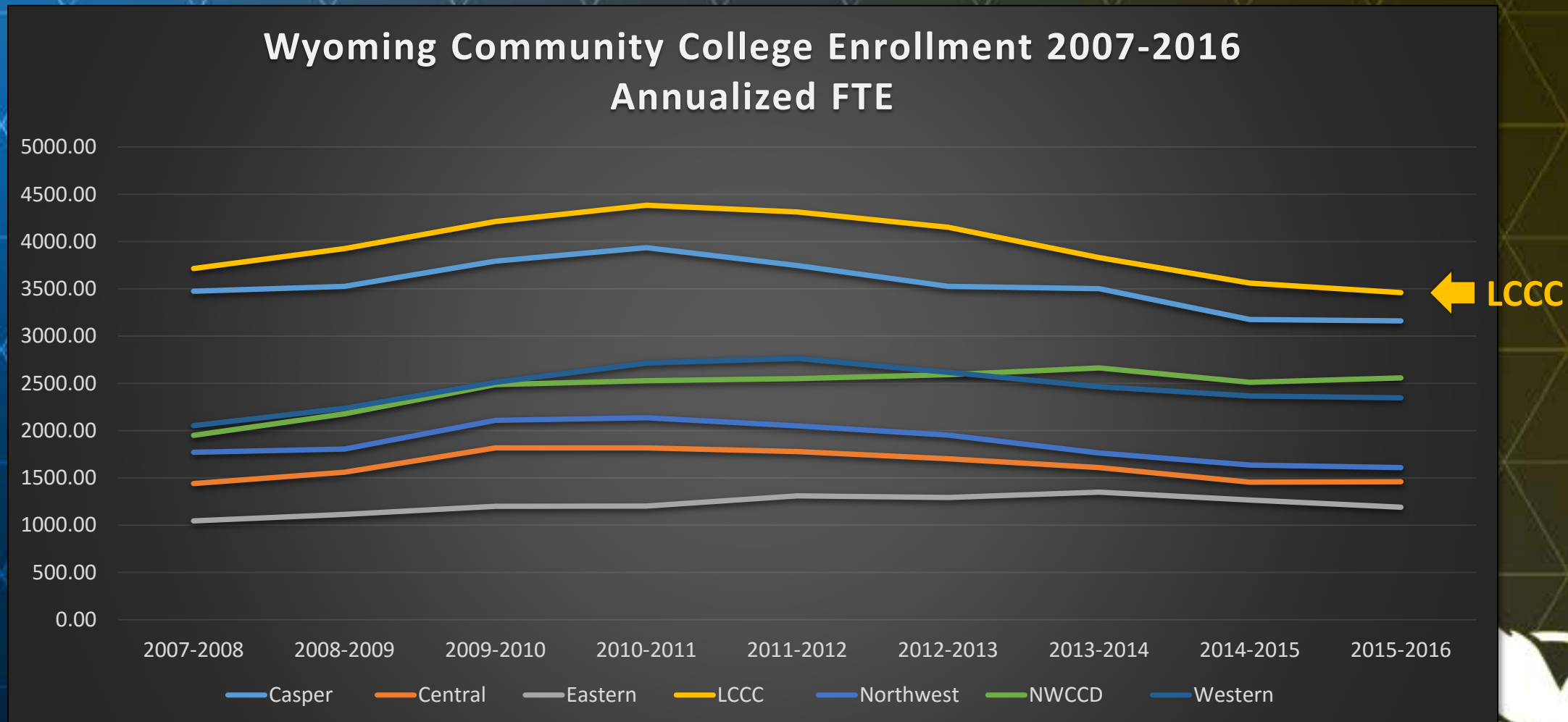
Wyoming CC Enrollment



By Wyoming CC (Headcount)

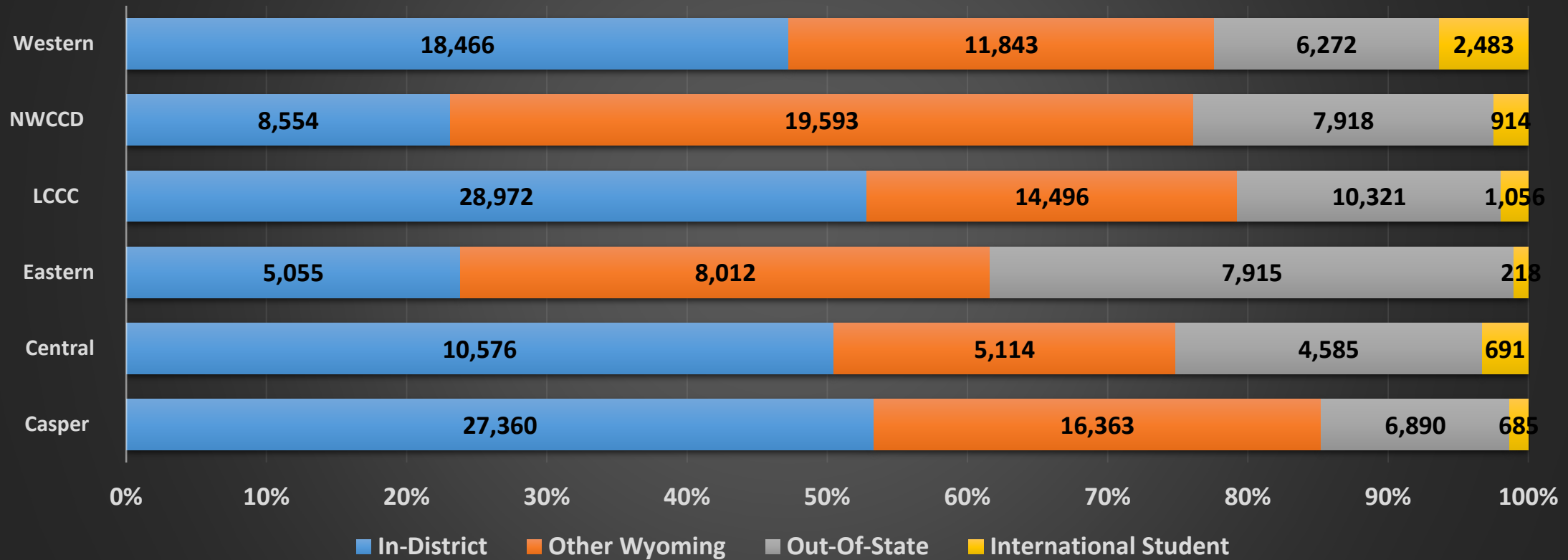


By Full Time Equivalents (FTE)

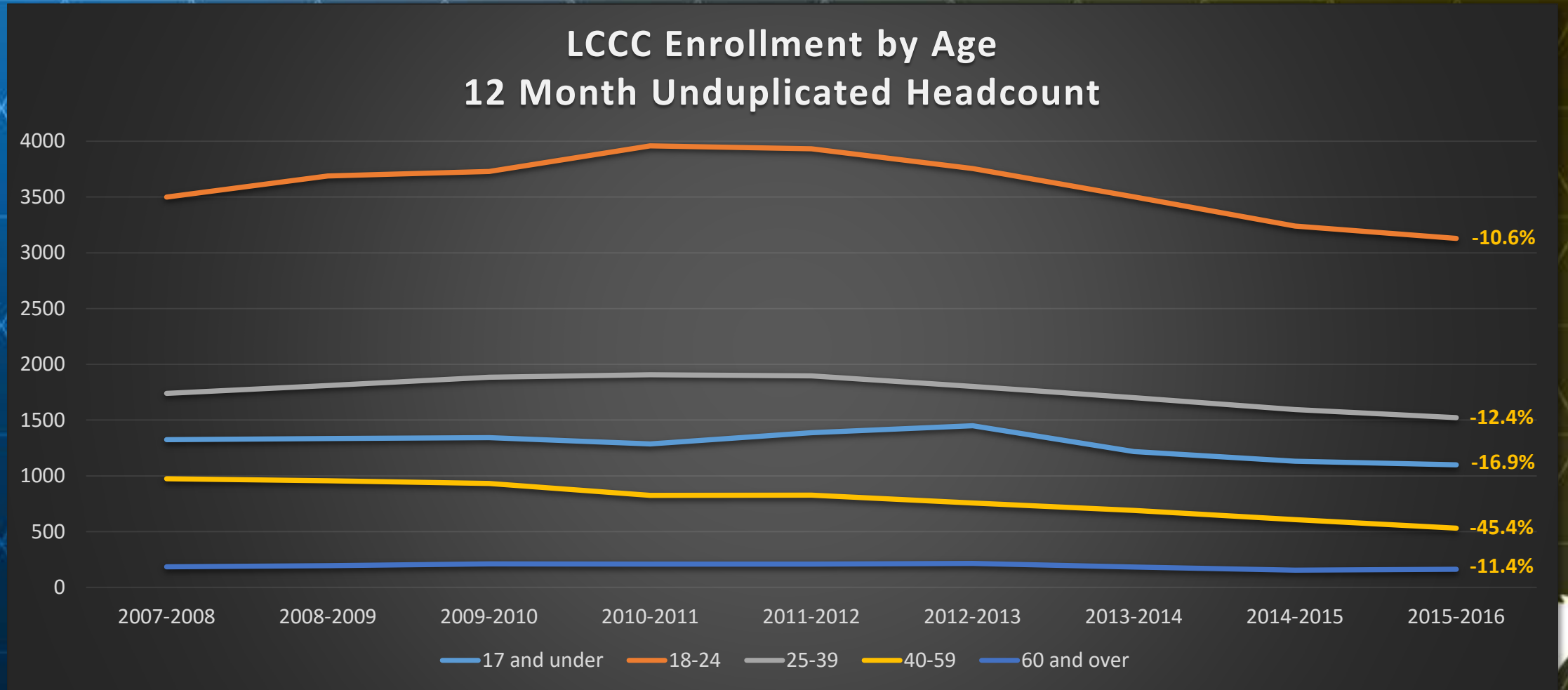


Enrollment by Residency WY CC's

Unduplicated Headcount FY14-FY16

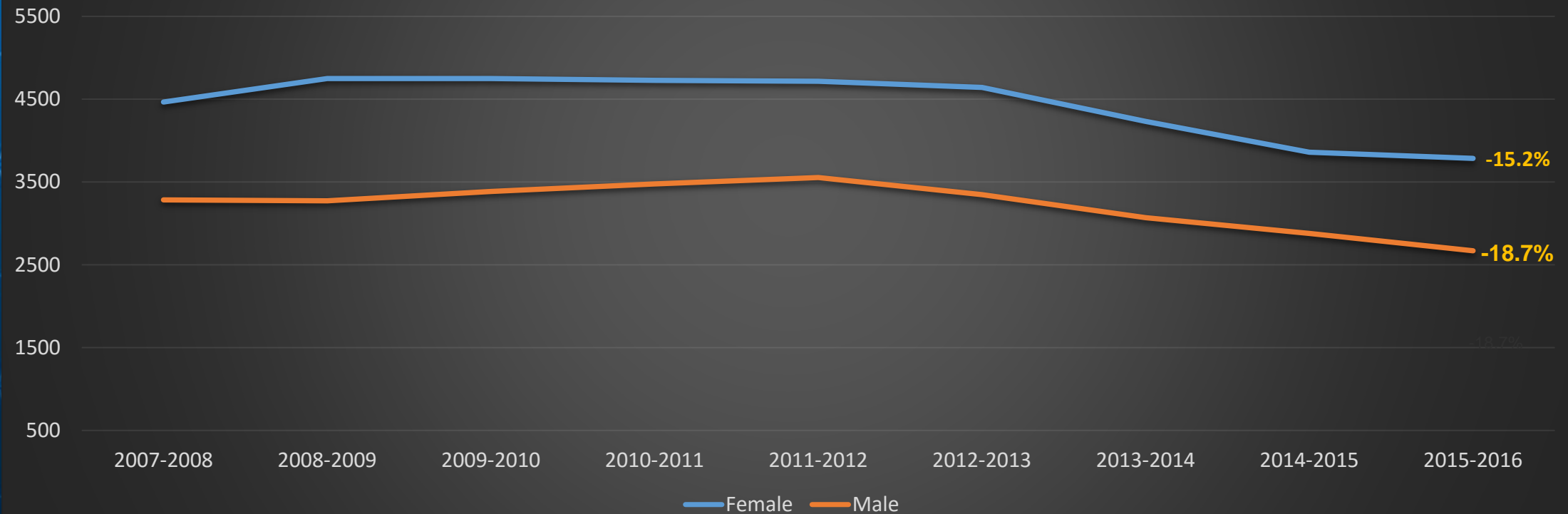


Enrollment Down Across all Ages



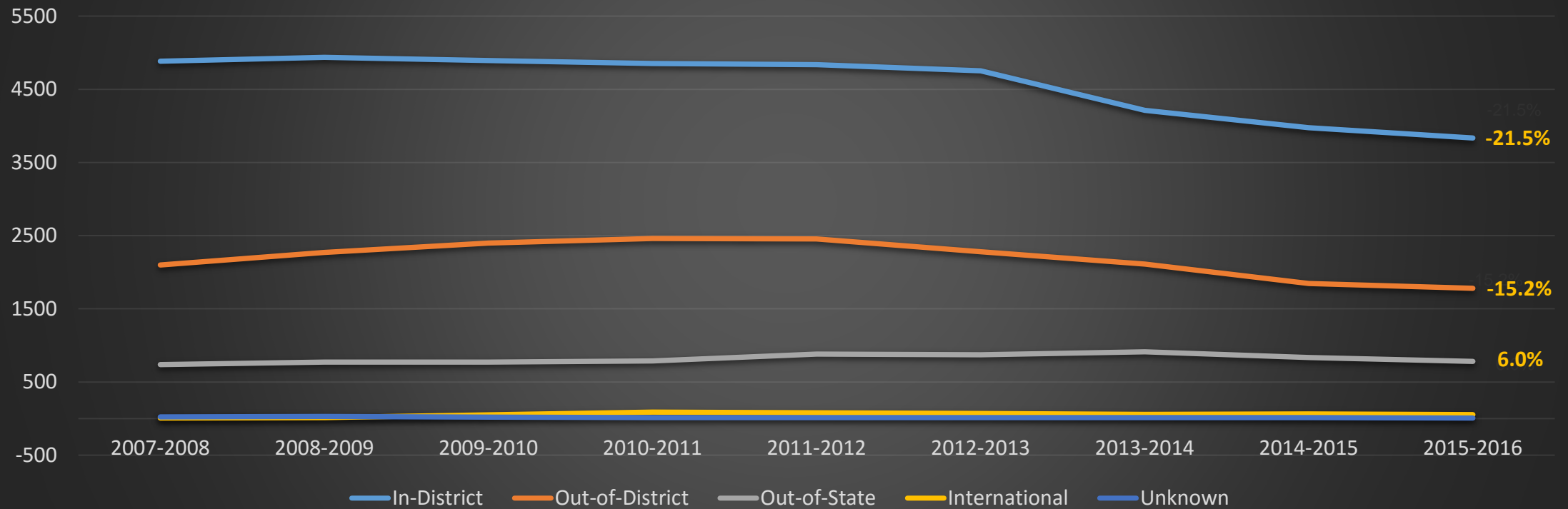
Men Down Slightly More than Women

12 Month Unduplicated Headcount

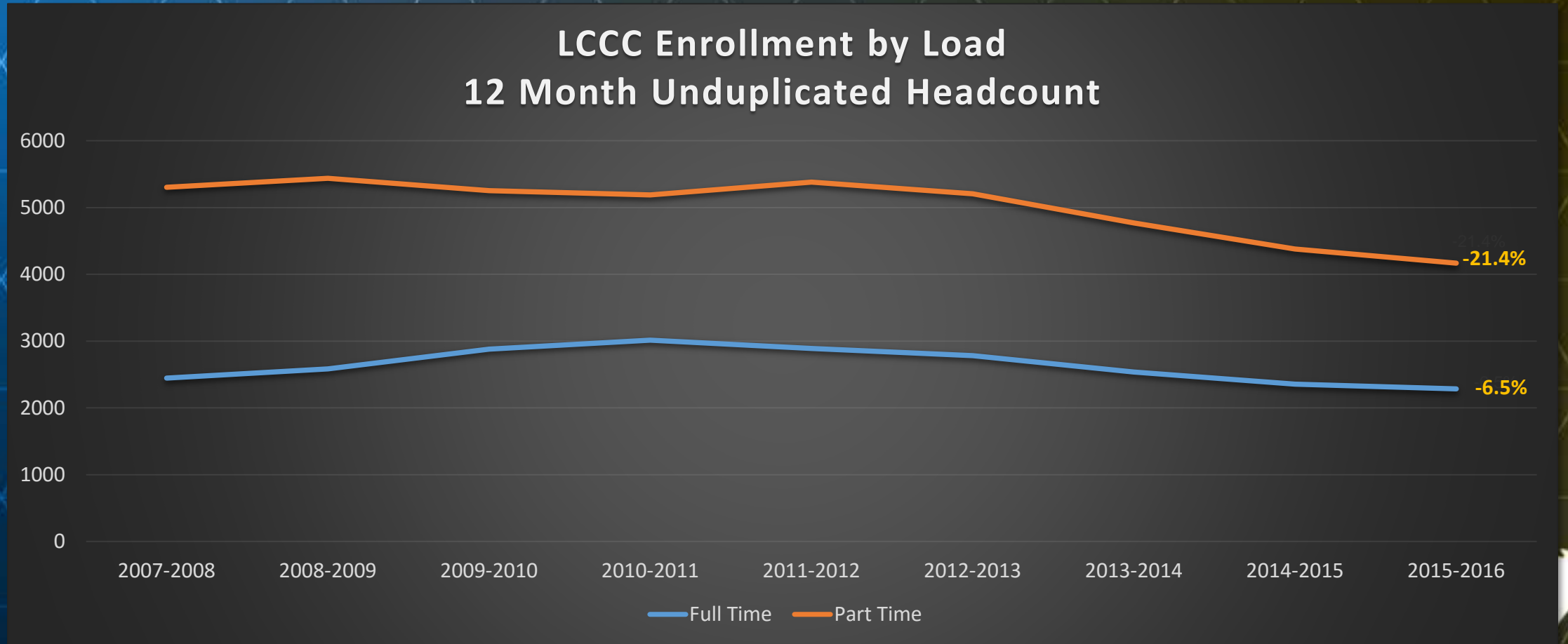


Closest Down the Mostest

LCCC Enrollment by Residency 12 Month Unduplicated Headcount

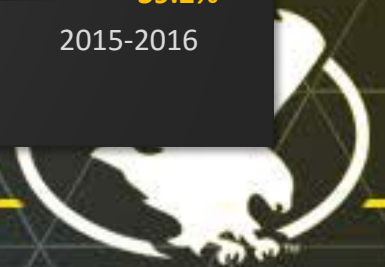
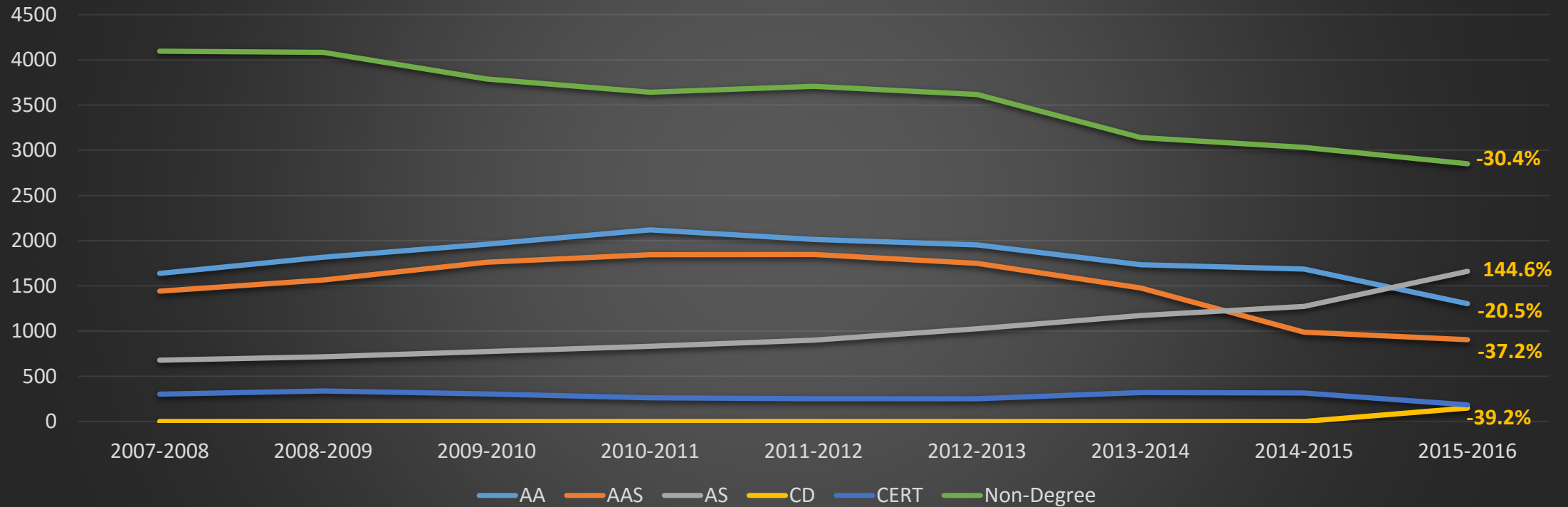


Far Fewer Part-Time Students

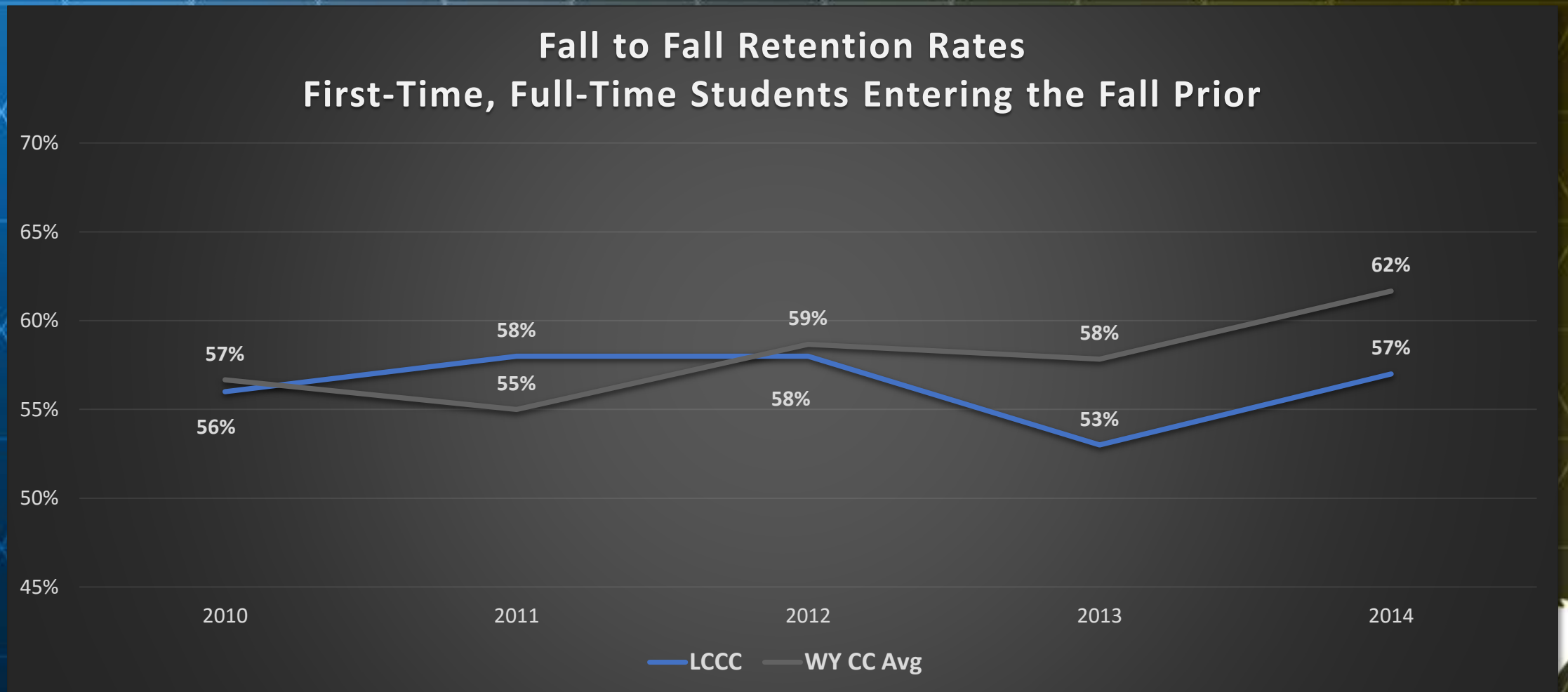


AS Degrees are a Bright Spot

12 Month Unduplicated Headcount

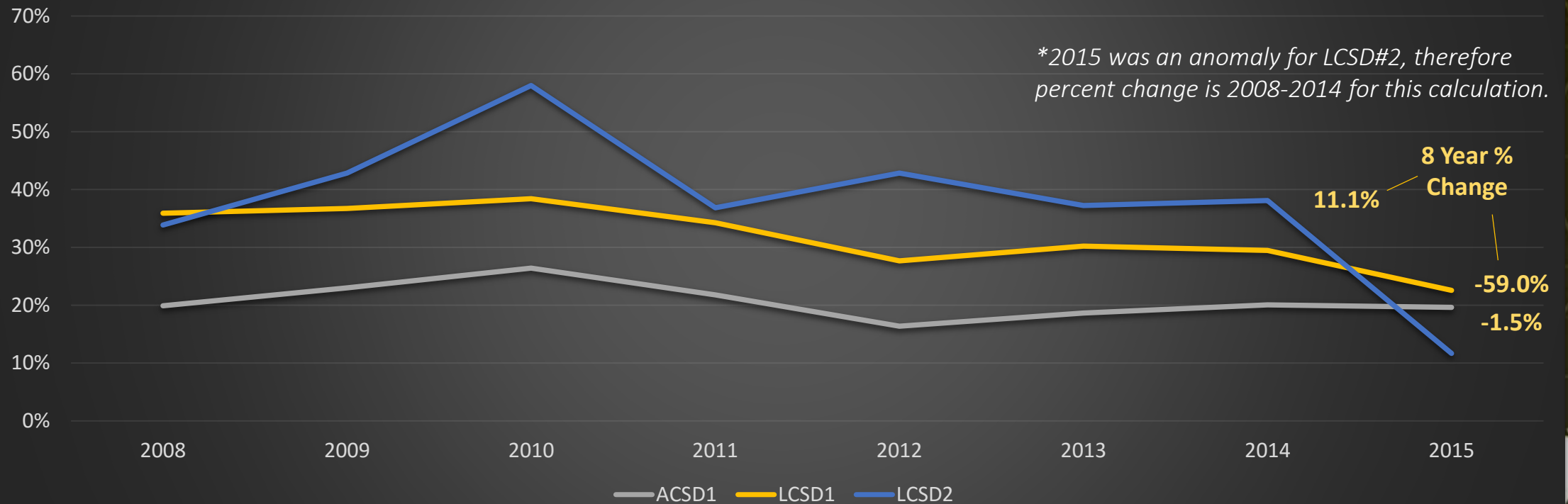


Retention Consistent, but Below State Avg.

Other Considerations

- High School Graduates in the West are projected to Increase
(Source: WICHE Knocking at the College Door)
 - Wyoming – 6,200 HS Grads per year through 2032 (24.4% Increase)
 - Colorado – 58,000 HS Grads per year through 2032 (18.5% Increase)
 - Nebraska – 24,000 HS Grads per year through 2032 (11.9% Increase)
- Wyoming's overall population is shrinking, especially in the working adult age groups.
