



# Your Checklist

When you apply, make sure to use an email address you frequently check. Your personal Admissions Rep will contact you and help guide you through the process.

First thing you'll need to do is complete an application online at apply.lccc.wy.edu. Once you've clicked submit, send us your official transcripts if you're a degree seeker. Do this at least two weeks before your start date. It's just that easy!

#### Placement

Show us what you've got and take a placement test at LCCC, or we may be able to place you based on your high school GPA or ACT scores. Check out lccc.wy.edu/placement.

### cientation

We want to get you familiar with the LCCC life and resources. Use myLCCC (the student portal) to sign up for orientation - lccc.wy.edu/myLCCC. There, you can open the "New User" folder and find orientation sessions available on our campuses in Chevenne and Laramie, as well as online.
