1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The Board of Trustees recognizes that the use and abuse of alcohol and other drugs impede students' health and educational goals. The Board expects the College to assure an alcohol and drug-free learning environment and maintain a drug and alcohol policy in compliance with Title IV Code of Federal Regulations requirements.

Further, the Board strongly encourages students to seek medical treatment for themselves and for others when necessary. The College has a primary concern for the health and safety of its students. Therefore, students who seek assistance for medical purposes will not be disciplined by the College for any violation of the College's drug or alcohol possession or consumption policies/procedures in which they might have engaged in connection with the reported incident.
