1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The purpose of the Student Code of Conduct policy is to document behavioral expectations of Laramie County Community College (LCCC). Each student at LCCC assumes an obligation as a responsible member of the educational community to demonstrate conduct compatible with the Student Code of Conduct.

A student is in violation of this policy if he or she:

- A. Intentionally aids or abets another in the commission of any offense(s) mentioned in this Code.
- B. Requests, hires, encourages, or otherwise solicits another person to commit any offense mentioned in this Code, either intending that the other person commit the offense or with the knowledge that the other person intends to commit the offense.
- C. Attempts to commit any offense mentioned in Procedure 3.14.1P Student Code of Conduct.
