1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The Board of Trustees is committed to maintaining a community in which students, faculty and staff can work and learn together in an atmosphere free from all forms of discrimination, including sexual harassment and sexual misconduct. The Board believes sexual harassment and/or misconduct violates the dignity of the individual and the integrity of the College as an institution of higher learning, and thus, discrimination, sexual harassment, and sexual misconduct in any form will not be tolerated.

In compliance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and other applicable federal, state and local laws, the College does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, disability, religion, age, veteran status, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, or other status protected by law.
