 - Here for our questions and concerns, across 62 classes, 1/3 of classes are health sciences. Using grants – we were able to help 16 students in nursing in multiple ways for 3 years, but grants are now expired. If something in the health science breaks, the fees will help cover replacements. Nursing students use ATI for \$600 per semester.
 - Tech fee: Adding a fee of \$100 for using existing products. Diesel has been running in deficits for the last few years; fee is to fix that.
 - Welding: Fee increase is actually good thing, reducing fees for separate safety classes.
 - CCA: Lab kits: paying more for things that won't be used.
