- 3. The student may be attending LCCC either on a part-time or full-time basis.
- 4. The student will be a woman over the age of 21.
- 5. The student will be a Laramie County resident.
- 6. The student will need to maintain a 2.0 grade point average. If the student is a current student, she must have a 2.0 grade point average to qualify.
- 7. The student will need to state her career goals and outline how she intends to fulfill these goals.

An interview with the Cheyenne Zonta Club members may be required.
